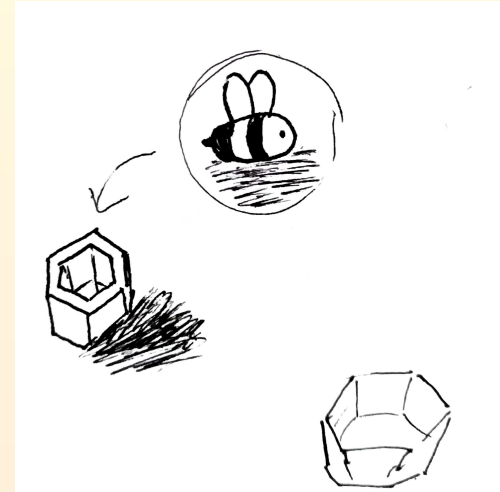
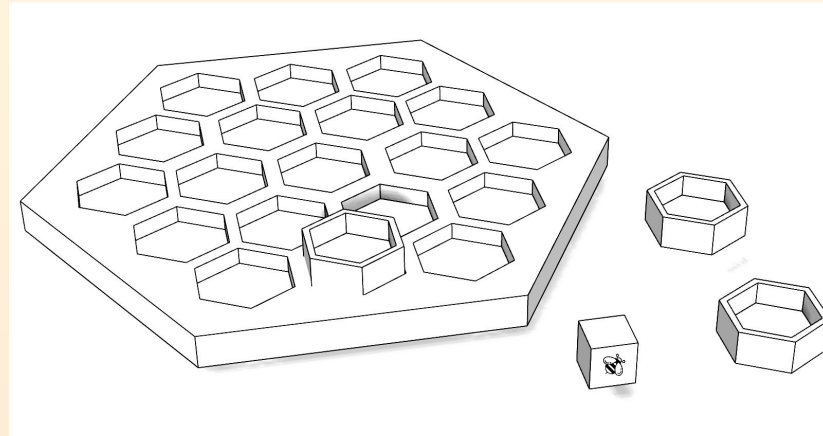
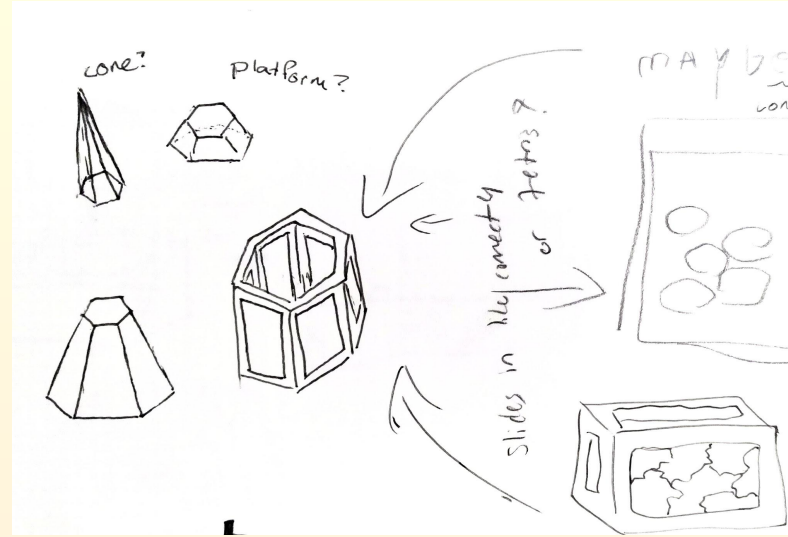
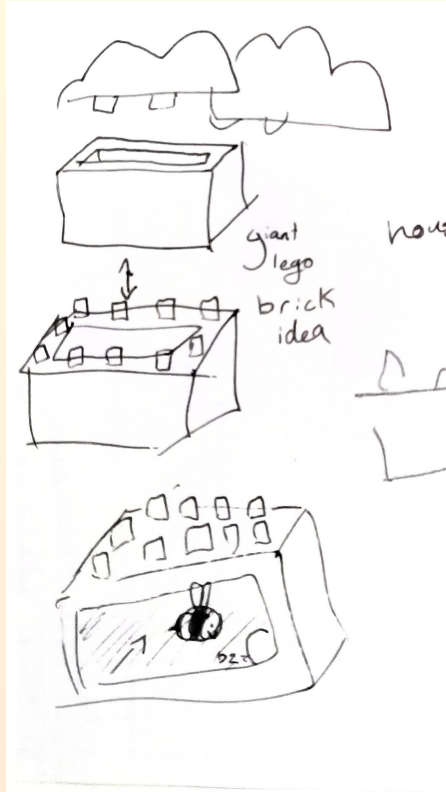


Apiarian is bee-based game with a goal of teaching others about bees and the danger they face on a daily basis while using Eco-friendly materials.

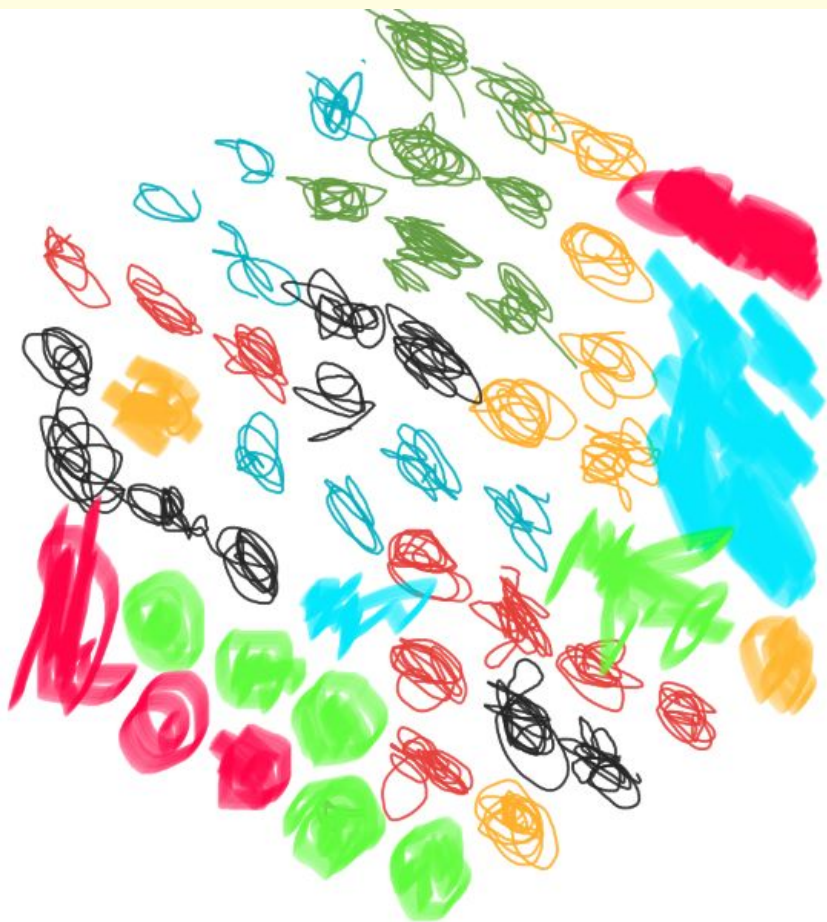

How to Play

For Ages 5+
2+ People Can Play

- 1 game board and 60-100 honeycomb pieces; 10 pieces of each color
- Each player takes turns putting a puzzle piece down/sending their bees into the field
- Each turn is 20 seconds long
- You can move other puzzle pieces but they have to be placed on the board before the timer expires
- First person to finish their hive wins



The afterlife of our game

- Each component of the game is made out of paper pulp, PLA, and wood which is both easily biodegrade and reusable.
- The game is also designed to be used with younger children, and in a K-3 setting, so the game could be used for years

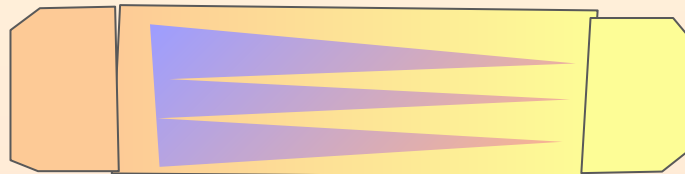
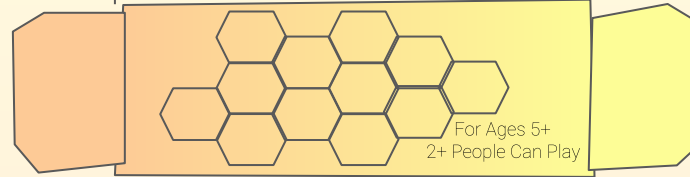


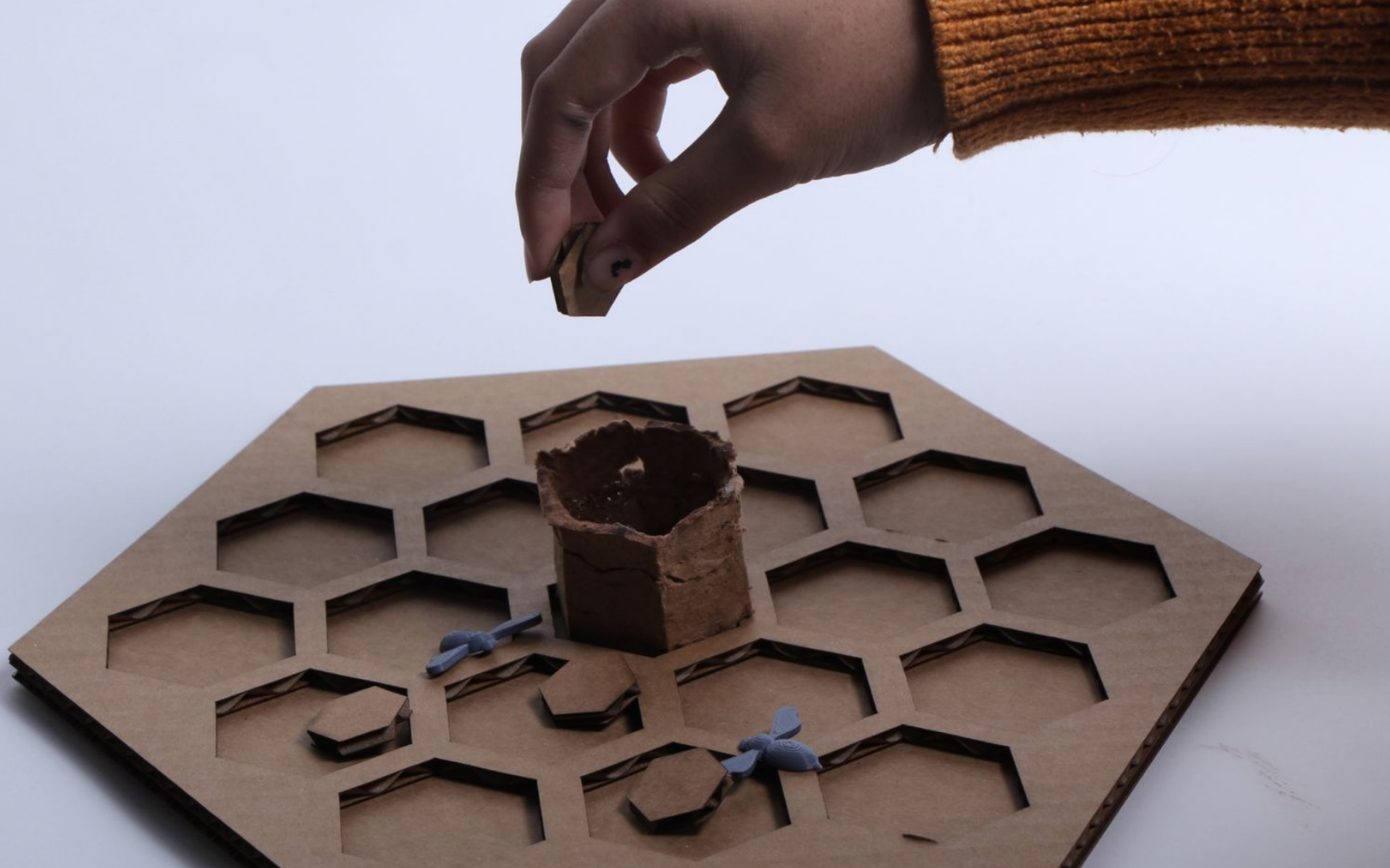
1 game board. 100 honeycomb pieces. Only 61 will fit on the board.
